Supervisor Breh said that she would have a talk with the school about the bus run on the Mill Road. She will suggest using the Mill Road in the morning and the County Road at night. She also stated that the Senior Citizens are happy with the Highway Department.

**Tryon Facility**

Supervisor Breh stated that a company out of Minnesota is going to put medical marijuana in the Tryon facility and it should be operating by January 2016. They will have about 100 employees.

**New Roof**

Supervisor Breh said that we have paid 113 of the invoice for the roof and they will start it when weather permits.
