Supervisor Cynthia Breh called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm with the Pledge to the Flag.

Highway Report

All mowing of shoulders is complete except for seasonal roads.

All hauling of winter sand will be completed by Thursday, July 21st

Culvert replacements on Belden Corners, Allen, and Cline Road will be started this week and will be completed by next week.

Diaphragm installation on the Youkers Bush Road was started on 7/18 and will be completed by 7/22. Mr. DeNinno is requesting permission to offer the 1970 GMC, 2004 International Dump and the Dynapak roller for sale at auction.

Mr. DeNinno recommends financing of the second new Medium Duty dump truck that was already approved for purchase. This would allow us to spread the payments out over two CHIPS cycles. We would pay half upon delivery in the fall of this year, and the remainder in April or May of 2023 which would be in the next CHIPS cycle

Nicholas Vasil wanted to know about the tires that people are throwing out along side the road. Mr. DeNinno said that the highway department picks them up. The County does not charge the town if they are picked up along the road.

Robert Norris made a motion to accept the Highway report and Nicholas Vasil seconded it and Kathleen Montana and Supervisor Breh were in favor.

Dog Control Officer

Ty Stowell was absent but had a report for the board members

Mr. Stowell has received calls about dogs barking during quiet hours and the owners were given a warning. He received a call about a dog at large on Sweet Hill Road and the owner was located and the dog returned.

Robert Norris made a motion to accept the Dog Control Officers Report and Nicholas Vasil seconded it and Kathleen Montana and Supervisor Breh were in favor.

Codes Enforcement Officer

Dave Rackmyre had a written report for the board members.

Dave Rackmyre issued 3 new permits and the total permit fees year to date is \$1,561.00. He served one ticket on State Highway 29.

He appeared in court on July 13, 2022 for tickets that were served to the owners of 6845 State Highway 29. They were given a conditional discharge until September as they are in the process of evicting the tenants. Mr. Rackmyre said it is possible that he will be subpoenaed to testify In the eviction hearing.
