Supervisor Cynthia Breh called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm with the Pledge to the Flag.

**Highway Report**

Scott DeNinno was absent but had a written report for the board members.

The installation of the required structural diaphragms on the Youkers Bush bridge have been completed.

Repairs and culvert replacements have been started on Sprite Club Road. This will smooth out the rough and washed-out areas in anticipation of resurfacing the road next year.

New road quotes have been obtained for all planned resurfacing jobs this year. Asphalt pricing has increased another 16% since the previous quotes from March (55% increase over last year). Mr. DeNinno recommends that we forego any paving or resurfacing this year. We would still complete all the required prep work for all roads to be resurfaced next year.

The Belden Corners culvert project is scheduled to start on Monday, August 22. The road will need to be closed for 2 to 3 days to complete the project.

The re-grading and raising of the road level on Cline Road near Krueger Road is tentatively scheduled to begin during the week of September 5. Information regarding closure will be addressed when the final schedule is set.

The surplus equipment will be listed for sale at auction/sealed bid once a duplicate title is obtained for the 2004 International, as the original cannot be located.

Cemetery mowing will take place again during the week of August 29, prior to Labor Day holiday.

Nicholas Vasil made a motion to accept the Highway report and Kathleen Montana seconded it and Supervisor Breh was in favor

### **Dog Control Officer**

Ty Stowell was absent but had a report for the board members

Mr. Stowell received a call about a dog bite on Mill Road and the victim is doing well and the dog is up to date on vaccinations.

Agriculture & Markets had an inspection report and everything is satisfactory.

Nicholas Vasil made a motion to accept the Dog Control Officers Report and Kathleen Montana seconded it and Supervisor Breh was in favor.

### **Codes Enforcement Officer**

Dave Rackmyre had a written report for the board members.

Dave Rackmyre issued 5 new permits and the total permit fees year to date is \$1,773.40.

He issued 5 violation notices.

Kathleen Montana made a motion to accept the Codes Enforcement Officers report and Nicholas Vasil seconded it and Supervisor Breh was in favor.
